### Scan Pack Custom Fields

CreateScanPack' and 'ScanPack' should be set as following

ZCreateScanPack

Y/N field

Field Length 1

Description Create Scan Pack

Tick enter on transactions, sales order only

ZScanPack

Y/N field

Field Length 1

Description Scan Pack

Do not Tick enter on transactions.

The Createscanpack option is used to manually create scan pack for new orders entered and is set to enter on transactions.

The ScanPack option is used to state that the scan pack process has been done on existing orders and is not set to enter on transactions.

The BMSSCANPACKPOLL.EXE cannot be run from a command prompt and needs to be called from Tailored Computer Solutions programs.

When you run it from a command prompt with the following options:

"C:\PROGRAM FILES\ADVANCED BUSINESS MANAGER\BMSSCANPACKPOLL.EXE 1 84777 SINGLE" it will open it in the task bar, and not display anything on the screen. It will run and create the scanpack file after pressing ALT-F4 to close the window.

BMSSCANPACKPOLL.EXE will not create any scanpack data if the output file exists. This is so PackNow can get the data. Once the output file disappears scanpackpoll will create a new one with all the orders that have been entered (and tagged) since the last time

You should also ensure that in BMS Suite for ABM -> EDI Sales Orders -> Settings -> Partner Settings that the customer is set up and is set to create a scan pack file.

The custom field should not be created manually, need to be initiated from appropriate exe

BMSEDI.EXE

creates field zscanpack

set zscanpack to 1

If system default set to scanpack or trading partner set to scanpack - create scanpack file

BMSSCANPACK.EXE

creates field zscanpack

Only selects orders where zscanpack <> 1

Sets ascanpack to 1
